In order to comply with Orange County Fire Regulations, the following requirements must be adhered to:

GAS ENGINE:

1. Vehicle(s) may not have more than 1/4 tank of gas or 10 gallons, whichever is less.
2. All fuel tank openings shall be locked and sealed in an approved manner to prevent the escape of vapors.
3. At least one battery cable shall be removed from batteries used to start engine, and the disconnected battery cable shall then be taped.

ELECTRIC ENGINE:

4. No gas tank since it is electric.
5. Battery cable does not need to be disconnected.

HYBRID ENGINE:

6. Vehicle(s) may not have more than 1/4 tank of gas or 10 gallons, whichever is less.
7. All fuel tank openings shall be locked and sealed in an approved manner to prevent the escape of vapors.
8. At least one battery cable shall be removed from batteries used to start engine, and the disconnected battery cable shall then be taped.

After the above listed items (1-3, 4-5 or 6-8) have been accomplished, the Event Security Provider (ESP) will confirm that all vehicle(s) in the booth are in compliance with Orange County Fire Regulations.

To prevent delays in the inspection process, please ensure that all battery compartments are visually accessible.

The Event Security Provider (ESP) will return all completed forms to the Event Security Liaison who will perform random spot checks to ensure compliance.
