

Policy: The Colorado Convention Center allows animals for

exhibit or on the surrounding grounds under the

following conditions:

Procedures:

- Animals must be accompanied by the keeper, owner or trainer at all times.
- Animals outside the display area must be on a leash or otherwise restrained.
- Animals displayed must be tied down, in a cage or otherwise restrained.
- Animal display areas must be kept clean at all times. Animal display areas must have a floor covering and the floor covering must be changed frequently enough so as not to cause lingering odor.
- The keeper/owner/trainer of the animal is responsible for immediate clean up of animal waste either inside or outside the facility.
- Show Management is responsible for any CCC maintenance costs as a result of display, exhibition, exercise or relief of animals.
- Animals to be displayed or exhibited must have the approval of show management.

- All associated display or exhibition materials used, i.e., drapes, fences, decorative materials etc., must be fire-retardant and must conform to all Denver Fire Prevention Bureau regulations for displays and exhibitions.
- Animals may load in and out through the exhibit hall roll doors.
- No animal may be exhibited or displayed that will in any manner endanger the safety or well-being of patrons.
- The Colorado Convention Center reserves the right of final approval for any and all animal displays and/or exhibitions.
- Additional insurance may be required for any/all animal displays or exhibitions as defined by company risk management authority.
- Service animals are an exception to the above regulations and shall be allowed to all event areas with their companion and shall remain on a leash or similar control device.
