### Motor Vehicle Display Guidelines

The following guidelines are to be adhered to:

#### Display of Vehicles

- The display of liquid and gas fueled vehicles and equipment inside of assembly occupancies shall be in accordance with this section.
- Vehicles shall not be moved at any time during show hours.

#### Batteries

- Batteries shall be disconnected.

#### Fuel Systems

- The transfer of fuel for vehicles or equipment shall not take place within a building or tent.
- Fuel in the tank shall not exceed one quarter of the tank capacity or five gallons, whichever is less.
- The fuel system shall be inspected for leaks.
- The fuel tank opening shall be locked and sealed to prevent the escape of vapors.

#### Location

- The location of vehicles or equipment shall not obstruct or block exits or access to fire alarm or sprinkler systems.

#### Vehicles used for Competitions and Demonstrations

- Liquid, gas fueled vehicles and equipment used for competition or demonstration within assembly occupancies shall be in accordance with this section.

#### Fuel Storage

- Fuel for the vehicles or equipment shall be stored in approved containers in an approved location outside of the building or tent.

#### Fueling

- The transfer of fuel shall be performed outside of the building or tent at an approved site.

#### Spills

- Fuel spills shall be cleaned up immediately.
