

### **FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- In the event that a portion of the exhibitor's back wall is a "fire exit door", the exhibitor must leave total access to it and may not drape, cover or obscure it in any way.
  - Total access must be available from aisles to exits (6-8') at all times, without obstruction of any kind.
- The following materials shall be flameproof if used for display or decorative purposes:
  - Flowers, foliage paper, cardboard, compressed paperboard less than 1/8 inch in thickness, plastic materials, split wood and bamboo fibres, styrofoam and textiles.
  - Wallpaper is permissible if pasted securely to walls or wallboard backing.
- It is not necessary to flameproof textiles, paper or other combustible merchandise on display for sale, but the quantity used shall be limited to the displaying of one salvageable length.
- Equipment must be set-up in such a manner to comply with approved safety standards and a suitable fire extinguisher may be required on recommendation of the inspector.
  - If at any time the fire inspector deems such equipment to be operated in a manner dangerous to public safety, he or she shall cancel the privilege of the exhibitor concerned.
- Flame shall not be used.
- Flammable liquids or gases shall not be stored inside the building.
- Displays must not encroach on exit doorways.
- Boxes, crates and cartons from which merchandise has been removed, must be neatly piled in a storage area.
